- Nearly 30 years experience in design, engineering and manufacturing




Our Pillars of Action

The group works collaboratively and is unique in its capacity to deliver bespoke and sustainable end-to-end solutions for our customers and partners.





Scopes

Scope 1


Direct emissions – The combustion of fuels owned or controlled by the reporting company Eg. diesel in a generator, gas in a boiler.

Scope 2

Indirect emissions - Caused by the production of energy consumed by the reporting company. E.g. The emissions from the fossil fuels burned to create the electricity for the lighting rig in a studio.

Scope 3

All emissions not covered in Scope 1 & 2 created by a company's value chain. Eg. Fan transport to a concert or the supply chain for foods used in a staff canteen.



Energy Baskets - Why?

An energy basket is used to collectively purchase energy for any number of individual entities but still contract them separately. They provide;

- Better commercials through economies of scale allowing access to deep green energy.
- Access to products normally reserved for larger consumers of energy.
- Forum to share best practices on broader sustainability and decarbonisation strategies.

The biggest event spaces and creative houses can support grass roots operators in their industry by grouping their energy demand together.

The trailblazing work that smaller and more nimble local actors are doing to trial new sustainable ways of working can be shared with larger, less reactive national operators.



Energy Baskets - How?



Renewable Energy is created by Ecotricity and we buy some from other UK sources too.

When we buy it, we buy it in chunks called clips.





A whole clip is **10GWh** (GigaWatt hours) and when we buy in multiple clips we get a discount.

Clips have a consumption shape to them with a **tolerance of +/-20%.**



Bringing together users with a shared goal but a variety of energy requirements, we can deliver better tariffs by buying more clips at once and blending tolerances and shapes together.






